With the understanding that any person who received South African citizenship on or before the introduction of the interim Constitution, will not be deemed to be HDI.

- "A woman" refers to a female person who is a South African cilizen.
- "Disability" refers to a person with a permanent physical disability, mental disability, awareness disability, which leads to confinement or disability, or the inability to perform bodily functions in the manner or within the capacity of a normal person.

"HDL equity ownership" refers to the percentage of a partnership or husiness that is owned by individuals, or in the case of a company, the percentage of shares which is owned by individuals who are actively involved in the management decisions and day to day operational activities of the company or business and who exercises control in the business in relation to their ownership at the close of tender.
